### **Explanation of Changes**

Total portfolio occupancy was unchanged from July. Although there were departing tenants at the Ichigo Yotsuya 4 Chome Building, Ichigo Higashi Gotanda Building, and Ichigo Hakata Building, Ichigo Office successfully brought in new tenants with no downtime.

### Value-Add Actions

As part of its ongoing efforts to enhance the quality and safety of Ichigo buildings for tenants, Ichigo Office has been installing Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in its buildings.

AEDs are frequently installed in hospitals, clinics, and ambulances, as well as public spaces such as airports, train stations, and schools, and Ichigo Office is now installing them in the first floor lobbies of Ichigo Office buildings for tenant use in emergencies. Ichigo Office's AEDs are equipped with voice guidance to explain their usage and have stickers attached to indicate that they are available for use by any and all persons in the area.

Ichigo Office will continue to work to deliver on the commitment to quality, safety, and productivity of the Ichigo Office brand.
