Explanation of Changes

Occupancy decreased for Office, Central Tokyo, and Tokyo Metropolitan Area due to departing tenants at the Ichigo Shibuya Udagawacho Building and Ichigo Eitai Building. Occupancy for Four Major Regional Cities increased due to a new tenant at the Ichigo Uchi Honmachi Building.

Value-Add Actions

As part of its ongoing efforts to increase tenant satisfaction via value-add capex, Ichigo Office has installed digital signage (branded as Ichigo Signage) in the elevator hall at the Ichigo Jingumae Building. The Ichigo Signage currently broadcasts news and promotional content to tenants and visitors waiting for elevators. Ichigo Office will soon add building and disaster-prevention information to the broadcasts, along with installing Ichigo Signage at other Ichigo Office buildings.

Ichigo Office will continue to drive further efforts to strengthen and deliver on the commitment to quality of the Ichigo brand.
