Ichigo Office today received S and A rank CASBEE (Comprehensive Assessment System for Built Environment Efficiency) certifications for the Ichigo Jingumae Building and the Ichigo Higashi Gotanda Building, respectively.

3. CASBEE Overview

CASBEE evaluates and rates buildings' environmental performance based on their energy and resource efficiency, recycling activity, environmental load, and aesthetic appeal.

CASBEE-certified buildings are scored for their environmental performance in five categories and receive a total environmental performance ranking (from highest to lowest): S, A, B+, B-, C.

4. Outlook

In line with sponsor Ichigo joining RE100, a global initiative to accelerate the transition of electricity used by businesses to 100% renewable energy, Ichigo Office is targeting to source 100% of the electricity needs across its assets (73 assets, excluding partially-owned assets) via renewable energy by the end of April 2022. As a result of already having transitioned 65 assets to renewable electricity as of the end of December 2021, Ichigo Office has reduced CO2 emissions by 19,622 tons, an 89% reduction compared to 2019.

As a specialized office REIT, Ichigo Office will continue to work to promote the environmental and energy efficiency and reduce the environmental impact of its office buildings.
